Directions

- Student reads the words one level at a time (use flashcards, word list or Powerpoint).
- If student does not respond in 3-4 seconds, prompt them by saying "What word?"
- *Mark correct words with a* \checkmark . *Mark incorrect or no responses with an* \mathbf{X} .
- Continue testing until the student misses 6 words in a row. If the student becomes unfocused, discontinue testing session and resume at another time.
- If desired, write down incorrect responses.
